### WHY JOHNNY CAN'T READ

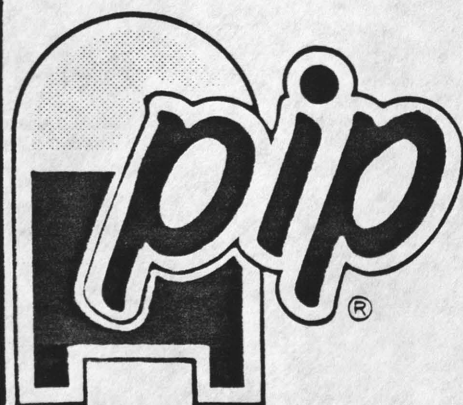
"I am home from school, Mommy."

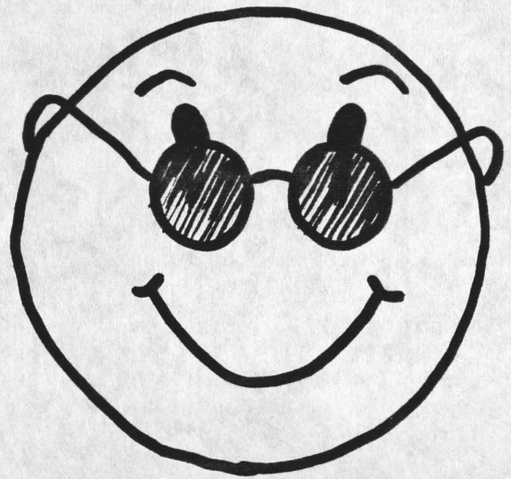
## NEWS BRIEFS
